that this plaster
structure is in situ,
because it is connected
to the wall. Our most
likely conclusion is that
it is a bin. This
structure is
consolidated.

In this pit the
composition was soft,
reddish-brown in color,
and had the following
inclusions: clay brick,
obsidian pieces, and
stones. This unit seems
to be the result of a
spot fire.
